A Celebration of 25 Years The Blue White Scholarship Foundation INTRODUCTION

Beginning in 2001, a dedicated group of graduates of Villanova University adopted the mission of providing scholarships to Villanova students in need of financial assistance to be able to graduate. Over time, too many Villanova students were finding that despite their efforts to utilize every effort to pay their tuition bills, including scholarship grants, federal and state loan programs, and family resources, they were still falling short. The Blue White Scholarship Foundation ("Foundation", or "BWSF") was formed to "Bridge the Tuition Gap" for these students, following on the tradition of its predecessor, the Villanova Educational Foundation, which had been raising money to support students involved in the University's athletic programs beginning in 1973, and ending this mission in 1999.

Looking back on its history over the past 25 years, the Foundation is proud of its singular accomplishment in awarding scholarships totaling more than Three Million Three Hundred Thousand (\$3,300,000) dollars to nearly four hundred students. These graduates are counted among the most industrious and successful individuals who can boast of obtaining a degree from Villanova University. That is why, to celebrate both the success of the Foundation, as well as our scholarship recipients, this collection of biographies is being produced and provided to our scholarship recipients, and to our most faithful donors over the past quarter century. If you are receiving a copy of this publication, you are on record as having supported BWSF in some way during this time, or you are one of the students who received a scholarship from the Foundation.

This collection of biographies is also accompanied by a number of light-hearted cartoons that poke fun at the nature of the academic process, as well as the many significant professions that result from the pursuit of higher education, in addition to reprint of materials that document the Foundation's annual program of newsletter publications containing highlights of the school year, and practical advice to our students and donors throughout the year. Please enjoy this additional entertaining and practical information along with the biographies that document the success of our scholarship recipients.

WHY OUR MISSION MATTERS

Even after Villanova University has allocated all available financial aid, many students still face a significant funding gap—putting their ability to graduate at serious risk.

- •According to U.S. News & World Report (2025), the average gap between demonstrated financial need and awarded aid is 18%.
- •55% of students apply for need-based aid, yet only 41% receive it. Of those, just 23% have their full financial need met, leaving 77% with unmet need despite receiving University grants and federal support. After Pell Grants, federal work-study, loans, and other scholarships, the average student supported by the Blue White Scholarship Foundation still faces \$17,000 in unmet financial need.

WHAT MAKES BWSF UNIQUE

- BWSF Responds to Life's Challenges: We prioritize helping students facing unexpected hardships such as a death of a parent or parent's job loss/ underemployment or illness in the family resulting in high medical expenses, or the challenge of multiple siblings in college.
- We support Student's Paying 100% of their Own Tuition: These individuals
 often work multiple jobs or take on significant debt to fund their education
- We supports students who fall into the "middle-class gap"—families who don't qualify for full aid but can't afford tuition out-of-pocket.
- Work Ethic & Academic Strength: Awards go to students who are working their way through school and maintaining strong academic performance.

The "Work Ethic" criteria was added in 2015. Students say there is no other scholarship like Blue White in the country. They have explained that being rewarded a BW Scholarship based on their resume and employer & professor references has made them feel proud that their efforts to contribute to the cost of their education is being acknowledged and valued.

- Pay-It-Forward Promise: Every recipient pledges to help future students, creating a lasting cycle of support.
- Mentoring & Education Program: Graduated Scholars help younger scholars.





3. Missing Contribution Deadlines

- · **Best practice:** Confirm your state's rules and set reminders to contribute in time.

4. Withdrawing Funds at the Wrong Time

- \cdot Only withdraw qualified expenses in the same calendar year you incur them?
- · Example:
- · A December tuition bill due in January?
- · Wait to pay—and withdraw—in January.
- \cdot Avoid using funds for non-qualified expenses, or you may face income tax and a 10% penalty.
- **Don't double-dip**: If expenses are covered by scholarships or other tax-free sources, don't also claim them from your 529.

5. Closing the Account Too Soon

- · If your child gets a scholarship, you can withdraw an equal amount without the 10% penalty—but you'll owe ordinary income tax.
- · Alternatives:
- · Use funds for graduate school.
- · Change the beneficiary to a sibling, grandchild, or even yourself—penalty-free if used for education.
- · Starting in 2024: Roll over up to \$35,000 from a 529 to a Roth IRA (conditions apply)
- · Account must be open 15+ years.
- · Roth IRA annual limits apply.
- · Beneficiary must have earned income.

Tips for Smart College Savings

- · Do your research: Each 529 plan has unique features, fees, and state-specific benefits.
- · Work with a financial planner to maximize tax advantages and contributions.
- · Consider other tools like Custodial Accounts or Coverdell ESAs for different goals or strategies

The Pluses and Minuses of PLUS Loans

A Parent Loan for Undergraduate Students (PLUS) is a federal loan option for parents to help fund their child's college education when other financial aid falls short. Here's a summary of its key advantages, disadvantages, and considerations.

Pluses of PLUS Loans: - Easy to Qualify: Most parents can qualify unless they have adverse credit history. - No Borrowing Limits: Borrow up to the full cost of attendance (minus other financial aid). - Fixed Interest Rate: Stable monthly payments aid in budgeting. - Tax-Deductible Interest: Up to \$2,500/year can be deducted if income requirements are met. - Flexible Repayment Options: Choose from Standard (10 years), Graduated (10 years), or Extended (25 years) plans. - Deferred Payments: Option to delay repayment while the student is in school at least half-time.

Minuses of PLUS Loans: - High Interest Rate: Often higher than private loans (e.g., 7.54%). - Origination Fee: Currently 4.228%, reducing disbursed funds and increasing total repayment. - No Practical Borrowing Limit: Risk of taking on excessive debt—borrow based on ability to repay, not just eligibility.

Tax Deduction Eligibility: - Full deduction if MAGI is \leq \$70,000 (single) or \leq \$145,000 (married jointly). - Phased-out deduction if MAGI is between \$70,000-\$85,000 (single) or \$145,000-\$175,000 (joint). - No deduction above these thresholds.

Alternatives to PLUS Loans: - Home equity lines of credit - Personal loans - Securities-backed loans Note: These may have better interest rates, but fewer borrower protections, and interest is usually not tax-deductible.

Consider Your Own Financial Future: Don't jeopardize your retirement savings to pay for college. Unlike education, you can't borrow for retirement. Always evaluate your long-term financial stability before committing to large loans.

Credit Building Tips

1. Building Credit History

Lenders use credit history/score to determine your credit worthiness. A low credit history/score can prevent you from qualifying for a credit card, home mortgage or car loan at the best possible interest rate. The Exchange Credit Program has created a set of credit guidelines to guide you in building your credit history/score.

- 1. **Payment history** (approximately **35%** of your credit score)
 - a. Pay your bills on time
 - b. Stay current on all your credit accounts
- 2. Account balances (approximately 30% of your credit score)
 - a. Keep low outstanding balances on credit cards
 - b. Pay off debt rather than shifting it between credit cards
 - c. Do not close unused credit cards (this can possibly lower your credit score)
 - d. Do not apply/open unnecessary credit card accounts
- **3. Length of credit history** (approximately **15**% of your credit score)
 - a. How long have you had credit
 - b. How often you use credit
- **4. New credit** (approximately **10%** of your credit score)
 - a. Manage how many new accounts do you have
 - b. Do not open several new accounts in a short time (this can possibly lower your credit score)
 - c. Maintain a good recent credit history
- 5. Types of credit used (approximately 10% of your credit score)
 - a. Credit score is a combination of all your outstanding credit cards, retail cards, loans, etc.
 - b. Closed accounts will show up on your credit report and may be included in your credit score

erroneous charges/accounts. A credit report containing mistakes will affect how potential lenders determine your credit worthiness.

What to Know About a Credit-Based Insurance Score

Your credit-based insurance score, or insurance credit score, is used to determine how likely you are to file a claim. It gives insurers an idea of how big of a risk you are to cover and helps them decide how much to charge you for coverage.

These credit-based insurance scoring models, created by data analytics companies like LexisNexis and FICO, have proved to be fairly accurate. A 2007 study — the latest data available — from the Federal Trade Commission showed that credit scores are an accurate indicator of whether someone will file an insurance claim. In addition, a 2003 study from the University of Texas showed drivers with the worst insurance scores are twice as likely to file an insurance claim when compared with drivers with the best scores, according to TransUnion, one of the three major credit bureaus.

In some cases, poor credit can increase your car insurance rates more than a recent DUI. In fact, rates for drivers with poor credit are 61% higher, on average, than for people with good credit, according to NerdWallet's 2023 rate analysis.

Besides auto, a credit-based insurance score can be used to determine other types of coverage such as home and renters. Generally, however, you'll get a separate score for each insurance type, although some companies, like LexisNexis, offer scores that can be used across multiple lines of insurance.

Although using credit-based insurance scores to calculate rates is legal on the federal level, insurance companies typically aren't allowed to use credit history as the sole reason for increasing rates or denying or canceling a policy. California, Hawaii and Massachusetts don't allow insurers to use credit when determining car insurance rates.

Credit-based insurance score vs. regular credit score

Your insurance credit score isn't the same as the more commonly known **Vantage Score or FICO credit score** that's used when you apply for a mortgage, credit card or **auto loan**. However, the factors used to determine your score are the same, just weighted differently. That's because a *credit score* is meant to estimate the likelihood you'll pay your debts, while the *credit-based insurance score* looks at how likely it is you'll file an insurance claim.

Because more than one company can issue a credit-based insurance score, your rating may differ from company to company. Regardless of the company, the higher your score, the better.

Factors used to create a credit-based insurance score are similar for LexisNexis and FICO but may differ when it comes to weighting. For example, below is a breakdown of how FICO weighs insurance credit scores, according to the Department of Insurance, Securities and Banking:

- •Payment history (40%): How you made payments on your debt, including frequency and the amount paid off.
- •Outstanding debt (30%)*: Amount of debt you have.
- •Credit history length (15%): Amount of time you have had a line of credit.
- •Pursuit of new credit (10%): Looks at whether you have recently applied for new lines of credit.
- •Credit mix (5%): The kinds of credit you have, including credit cards, mortgage or auto loans.

Based on the categories above, the following could negatively affect your insurance credit score:

- Missing payments.
- Having little to no credit history.
- Too many hard credit inquiries. (A hard credit pull occurs when you apply for an auto, student or personal loan, mortgage or credit card.)
- High credit card balances as compared with your credit limits, known as your credit utilization.

Like with a regular credit score, personal information cannot be used to determine your credit-based insurance score, including: Gender, Race, Marital status, Religion, Age, Income and occupation, and Location of residence. Although your credit score and credit-based insurance score aren't the same, your credit score can be a good indicator of your credit-based insurance score. If you have a decent credit score, your credit-based insurance score is likely (but not always) on par.

Steps To Pay Off Student Loan Debt and Take Charge of Your Finances

Get Your Loan Details in Order

You may have a mix of both federal and private loans. You must know what loan you have and their respective repayment terms.

1. Look Up Your Loan Servicer

Federal Loans: Use the National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS) with your FSA ID to find your servicer.

Private Loans: Check your credit report at AnnualCredit-Report.com to identify lenders.

2. Figure Out Your Interest Rate

Log into your loan servicer's website. Check if your loan has a **fixed** or **variable** interest rate.

3. Identify Your Payment Due Date

Know your monthly due date to avoid delinquency, default, and penalties like credit damage or wage garnishment.

4. Check Your Loan Payoff Date

Federal loans typically have a 10-year term, extendable up to 30 years.

Private/refinanced loans may vary; longer terms mean more interest paid over time.

Identify Your Payoff Goals

Choose your main objective—pay off loans fast, lower monthly payments, or balance repayment with other financial goals.

1. Pay Off Loans Quickly

Focus on eliminating debt early to reduce stress and interest costs.

2. Reduce Monthly Payment

Prioritize short-term financial flexibility by lowering monthly payments, even if it extends your loan term.

3. Save for Other Goals

- •Use repayment strategies that allow you to save for milestones like buying a home, building an emergency fund, or starting a family.
- •Consider a hybrid approach: pay extra toward loans while saving for other priorities.

Consider Ways to Modify Your Payments

Adjust your repayment approach to either pay off loans faster or reduce monthly costs.

1. Refinance Student Loans

- Apply with a private lender for new terms.
- Lower interest rates may reduce monthly payments.
- Longer terms (up to 20 years) lower payments but increase total interest.

Note: Refinancing federal loans removes access to federal benefits like IDR plans and forgiveness.

2. Apply for an Income-Driven Repayment (IDR) Plan

- Available for federal direct loans.
- Payments based on income and family size.
- Terms extend to 20–25 years; remaining balance may be forgiven. Some borrowers qualify for \$0 monthly payments.

3. Consolidate Federal Loans

- · Combine multiple federal loans into one.
- · Simplifies payments with one servicer.
- Extend term up to 30 years; lowers monthly payment but increases interest. Interest rate becomes a weighted average of prior loans.

4. Take Advantage of Loan Discounts

Enroll in autopay to reduce interest rate by 0.25%.
 Ensures on-time payments and may lower monthly costs.

5. Use Employer Assistance Programs

Some employers match student loan payments.

Choose a DIY Payoff Strategy

Accelerate loan repayment without changing loan terms through these self-managed tactics.

1. Increase Your Autopay Amount

Boost automatic payments annually (e.g., +10% or +\$100). Instruct your servicer to apply extra payments to principal, not future bills.

2. Use Spare Change Apps

Apps like ChangEd or Digit round up purchases and save the difference. Apply those savings toward loan payments.

3. Apply Avalanche or Snowball Methods

Avalanche Pay off loans with highest interest first—saves money.

Snowball: Pay off smallest balances first—offers quicker wins and motivation.

4. Apply Unexpected Windfalls

Use bonuses, gifts, or tax refunds to make lump-sum payments. Example: A \$2,772 refund on \$30K debt at 4.53% interest could save \$1,400+ and cut 13 months off your term.

5. Don't Neglect Emergency and Retirement Savings

Student loan repayment is important, but so are other financial priorities.

- Build and maintain an **emergency fund** to protect against job loss or unexpected expenses.
- Contribute to **retirement savings** early to benefit from longterm market growth.
- Choose a **balanced strategy** that supports debt repayment while allowing room for savings.

Allyson Weaver '18 Nursing




